Subject: Employment Fingerprinting

As a courtesy to the public and citizens of Somerset County the Somerset County Jail will be doing Employment fingerprint cards on Saturday mornings 0900-1100 hours. Somerset County citizens should have a picture ID and 2 blank cards (please do not pre-fill in the blanks). We utilize an inkless system that verifies the quality of prints prior to printing them utilizing a computer printer. Note: our system exceeds FBI and State Bureau of Identification standards for inked cards and is accepted by both.

Persons to be fingerprinted will be asked to call at least 24 hours in advance to 474-7409 ext 2050 and make an appointment. Please, identify to the answering officer that you are making an appointment for Employment fingerprinting. When arriving please, report to the Lobby, where your identification will be verified against your photo identification, you will then go through our metal detector, store your non-allowable property in a locker (cost: a quarter), and be escorted to our booking area for fingerprinting. The above time period may be curtailed due to an arrestee booking having to take place and we will attempt to resume or complete your fingerprinting when the Booking area becomes available, this is for your safety. You should expect to take up to a half hour to complete this process.
